If you are looking to do something with the family, zoom in on an amazing wildlife in its natural habitat from the Seabird Centre, make a splash at Dunbar Leisure Pool or with the outdoor team at Foxlake Adventures.

Discover the region's rich history and culture at one of our fascinating museums, castles or heritage sites. Learn about John Muir, the founder of the National Parks in America; our industrial heritage and everything from our earliest settlers to modern times on a visit to one of East Lothian Council's museums. Uncover the story of aviation from the First World War to the present day at the National Museum of Flight, where you can step on board Scotland's Concorde. Step back in time on a visit to last of the grand medieval castles, Tantallon Castle or the peaceful Seton Collegiate Church.

See the longest herbaceous border at Dirleton Castle or visit St Mary's Church in Haddington, notably Scotland's largest church.

Absorb history, nature and adventure with a visit to Newhailes in Musselburgh, a conserved 17th century house, plus Inveresk Lodge Garden and Preston Mill.

Learn traditional green woodworking, bushcraft and survival skills with Tree-ditions Woodland Crafts School.

Walk along the John Muir Way or catch the East Coast bus and take in some beautiful coastal scenery.

There is a varied choice of entertaining shows, all year round, at The Brunton and the chance to have a flutter at Musselburgh Racecourse. And, don't forget to sample a wee dram at our own Glenkinchie Distillery.






